July Saturday the 11 1835
Commences with light breeze at 3 PM
saw the Island of Aldabra bearing ESE
Dist 5 leagues at sunset stood off and
on latter part squally

Sunday July the 12

Commences with pleasant weather
went on shore and got a tree for
topsail sheet bit at returned boats crew
went on shore for turtle got one
at 9 AM returned kept the ship N 40

Monday July the 13

Commences with fresh wind and
pleasant latter part rugged Employed
in making topsail sheet bit

Tuesday July the 14

Commences with light breeze latter
part moderate and pleasant steering
to the westward

Wednesday July the 15

Commences with light breeze middle
part fresh at 10 AM saw a school of
whale toward three boats fastened
and turned up 5 sun. one so ends these 24

Thursday July the 16

Commences with fresh wind at 3 PM took
two whale along side for the larboard
boat two for the waist boat one for the
starboard boat total 5 at 4 commenced
cutting but in one and began to boil
at 8 AM began to cut so ends these 24 hours

Friday July the 18

Commences with all hands
Employed in cutting at 3 finished
and commenced boiling middle
part fresh wind and rainey
latter part strong gales

at 4 AM finished boiling and spoke the
sleearald Capt Lincoln with 500 and
gamed with her

Sunday July the 20

Commences with light breeze middle part
cloudy at daylight strong breeze saw
a school of whale toward come a
heavy squall did not get fast

July the 21 Monday

Commences with all hands Employed
in working ship for whale at 4 PM
toward the larboard boat struck
and killed at sunset took him
along side at 7 AM cut him in and
cleared up the decks

Tuesday July the 22

Commences with light breeze and pleasant
weather with all hands Employed in
boiling at 2 AM finished at daylight
began to brake out to stow down
stowed down this day 46 barrels

Wednesday July the 23

Commences with pleasant weather
with all hands Employed in
stowing down at 12 AM finished
these 24 hours ends with pleasant weather

Thursday July the 24

Commences with all hands
Employed in stowing off the load
at 12 PM toward for whale the
larboard boat struck and drawed
latter part fine Employed in
making mizen top gallant yard
