Thursday Oct the 8 1835
Commences with ~~the~~ light wind
and pleasant in sight of the
Islands of Make with a strong current
setting to the North so ends these
24 hours with a calm.

Friday Oct the 9
Commences with a calm
but pleasant middle part light
breeze from the S.W. stood in for
the land it bearing East strong
current setting to the S.W. fell to
Leeward and stood off latter part
light breeze

Saturday Oct the 10
Commences with light breeze
and pleasant steering towards
the Amarantha Island and saw it
at 8 am bearing S.W. Dist 8 leagues
so ends these 24 hours with a calm

Sunday Oct the 11
Commences with a calm Dist
from the Amarantha Island
2 leagues middle part and latter
fine and pleasant breeze

Monday Oct the 12
Commences with light breeze and
pleasant middle and latter
part brisk breeze from the
S.W. so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday Oct the 13
Commences with light wind
and pleasant weather at
daylight saw the Island
of Make Dist 14 leagues bearing
at 10 am sent the Chans. ⁸⁶
and got ready to anchor

Wednesday Oct the 14 1835
Commences with light wind
at sunset came to anchor off ^{fath}
the mouth of the harbour of Make 28
so ends these 24 hours

Thursday Oct the 15
Commences with all hands employed
in heaving short at 8 am got
under way at 4 PM came to anchor
under St Anne in 12 fathoms
and was boarded by the health
officer ~~sent~~ at sunset the
Capt went on shore and put
himself under the Doctors hands

Friday Oct the 16
Commences with pleasant weather
at 9 am sent a raft of Casks on
shore for water so ends these 24 hours

Saturday Oct the 17
the barque Apholan Make
arrived with 25 barrels 3 months
out

Sunday Oct the 18
all hands on shore
