long in squally latter part pleasant so ends
theseabouts

Monday Dec the 7
Commences with pleasant weather
S by S Dist 10 miles from whence
long in saw blackfish light wind and
cloudy so ends theseabouts

Tuesday Dec the 8
Commences with squally and rainy
S by S Dist 10 miles from whence
long in saw blackfish light wind and
cloudy so ends theseabouts
