Friday Dec the 4 1835
Commenced with pleasant weather
this day left the port of Make with
the number of 21 men the Capt being
sick on shore he gave the ship in charge
for a cruise to his first Officer
William Stoddard

Saturday Dec the 5
Commenced with pleasant weather
Lat. Ob at 6 AM the Island of Salthette bearing
N. 23° E by 18 Dist 10 miles from whence
long in in take my Departure at 6 AM Crossed
53.298 the Edge of the Bank so ends these 24 hours

Sunday Dec the 6
Lat Ob Commenced with pleasant weather
54.00 loward for blackfish Middle part
long in squally latter part pleasant so ends
52.34 these 24 hours

Monday Dec the 7
Lat Ob Commenced with pleasant weather
54.45 Middle part squally latter part
long in saw blackfish light wind and
52.25 Cloudy so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday Dec the 8
Lat Ob Commenced with squally and rainy
54.28 weather middle part pleasant and
long in latter part light breeze from the N
52.25 at 1 PM Doubled back to the
Island of Salthette
