Wednesday Dec the 7th

Lat Obs Commences with squally weather
3.57.28 Middle part calm and pleasant
Long in at daylight saw the Island of Wake
54.45.6 Dist 15 leagues so ends these 24 hours

Thursday Dec the 10th

Lat Obs Commences with light breeze and
4.40.28 pleasant weather middle part calm
Long in latter part light breeze from the
54.39 N.W. steered off to the southward
so ends these 24 hours

Friday Dec the 11th

Lat Obs Commences with light breeze and
4.50 pleasant latter part squally
Long in steered off at 11 AM at 12 AM judged
54.40 our selves on the Edge of the bank

Saturday Dec the 12th

Lat Obs Commenced with pleasant weather
at daylight saw a school of whale
toward the west boat got fast
and saved two whale the larboard boat
one at 12 AM took them along side

Sunday Dec the 13th

Lat Obs Commences with all hands employed
in cutting in at sunset finished
3.58 at daylight Cleared off the heads and
Long in commenced boiling this 24 hours ends
53.57 with squally weather

Monday Dec the 14th 1835

Lat Obs Commences with strong breeze from
the S.W. at 5 PM saw a school of
4.13 whale toward whales going joined did
Long in not get fast latter part moderate
53.40 at 12 AM struck groundings on the
Edge of the bank

Tuesday Dec the 15th

Lat Obs Commences with light breeze and
3.28 squally at 12 AM finished boiling middle
Long in and latter strong breeze so ends these
54.37 24 hours

Wednesday Dec the 16th

Commences with strong breeze and
Lat Obs squally middle part light wind
4.24 Cloudy at 8 AM saw Bird Island
Long in bearing SW Dist 5 leagues this 24 hours
53.44 with squally weather

Thursday Dec the 17th

Commences with light wind and Cloudy
Lat Obs at 1 PM sent a boat on shore at 4 PM returned
3.35 left three men on shore for turtle
Long in at 7 AM sent a boat on shore for the
53.28 men but did not get away turtle latter
part saw a number of blackfish

Friday Dec the 18th

Lat Obs Commences with light wind and Cloudy
3.22 at 8 PM called all hands Cleared the
Long in main topsails and hove two with the
53.48 wind S.E. at daylight fine weather
saw Dennis Island bearing S.E. Dist 6 leagues
