lat 42° 20' Sunday Jan the 3 1836  
Commences with light breeze and  
long in pleasant weather saw number of  
grampuses and finbacks so ends these  
24 hours with fine breeze from the North

Monday Jan the 4  
Commences with pleasant weather at 2 PM  
long in toward for whale going quick did not get  
fast at 4 PM toward for whale the waist  
boat struck and raised these 24 hours  
ends with pleasant weather

Tuesday Jan the 5  
lat 42° 01' Commences with pleasant weather  
light wind so ends these 24 hours  
long in

Wednesday Jan the 6  
lat 42° 20' Commences with light wind at 2 PM  
saw the Island of prolan bearing SW  
Dist 4 leagues middle part sharp lightning  
with thunder so ends these 24 hours  
long in 58° 46'

Thursday Jan the 7  
Commences with fine breeze from the North  
get the anchors to the bow and but the  
chain at 2 PM sent the boat on shore  
while the ship stood off and on at 5 PM  
the boat returned with orders to come to  
Anchor at 8 PM come two or 3 fathoms water  
the peak of it turns bearing Ok N Dist 2 miles

Friday Jan the 8  
the Mate on shore had difficulty with the boat  
and said he would do no more duty  
board the ship so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday Jan the 12  
Commences with unpleasant weather the  
Capt came and Mate came on board  
with the police the Mate refused to do  
any more duty on board of the ship

Wednesday Jan the 13  
Commences with pleasant weather  
went on shore with the boat and  
brought the Capt & others off

Thursday Jan the 14  
Commences with rainy weather

Friday Jan the 15  
lat 42° 00' took our anchor to our bow and stood  
out of the harbour of Make the Mate  
went to his duty at 8 PM the island  
of Ladig bore SW Dist 6 leagues latter  
part heavy rain so ends these 24 hours  
long in 58° 00'

Saturday Jan the 16  
lat 42° 25' Commences with really weather and  
rain at sunset 10 PM in sail and stood  
boat coxed this 24 hours ends with  
unpleasant weather  
long in 58° 40'
