Commences with pleasant weather at 2 PM sent
the light things on shore at 4 went himself
self and gave the ship in charge to his
Mate to cruise two months at 11 AM
ship Conservative arrived 32 months out
2100 barrels and a Chastrian man of war
one french sloope of war lying in side
of the reef
