6 Thursday April the 7
Commenced with light breeze and
sailing standing in for the land
butter part got a raft of Casks on deck
so ends these 24 hours

Friday April the 8
Commenced with light wind at
PM. came to anchor at Anns bearing
East at 10 AM sent the raft on shore

Saturday April the 9
brought off Raft. Water and
sent a raft on shore

Sunday April the 10
Commenced with pleasant weather
at 6 AM the Capt came on board
and brought his things had some
trouble with the Doctor at 3 AM went
on shore and towed off the Casks
and got under way and stood out of
Reaches of Madag so ends these 24 hours

Monday April the 11
Commenced with pleasant weather
at 2 PM saw the Island of St. Paul bearing
West Dist 5 leagues at sunset sent a boat
on shore for turtle the land 8 miles
off at 10 AM came on board with three

Tuesday April the 12
Commenced with pleasant weather
at 1 PM sent a boat for wood at
sunset sent a boat turtle came on board
at daylight returned with 5 got under

lat 06 Thursday April the 28
9.10 Commenced with brisk breeze and pleasant
long in weather latter part moderate
157.19

Friday April the 29
lat 06 Commenced with light breeze and
10.14 pleasant at daylight saw the Island
long in Galaga and sent a boat on shore
156.30 this island is long and low uninhabited
with a few blacks abounds with Coconuts

Saturday April the 30
lat 06 Commenced with light breeze and
11.05 pleasant weather at sunset the
long in Galaga bearing East Dist 1 league
155.00 from whence I take my Departure

lat 06 Sunday May the 1
12.11 Commenced with light breeze and
long in pleasant weather so ends these 24
154.48

Monday May the 2
Commenced with pleasant weather
middle part strong breeze at daylight
saw the Island of Madagascar 20 miles
south of Cape Amber at 4 PM came to
anchor in the Entrance of British Sound

Tuesday May the 3
Commenced with pleasant weather
sent men on shore to cut wood had
a few Natives come on board to
see about Trade so ends these 24 hours
