8.24 Wednesday June the 29
Commences with heavy wind saw
schools of whale toward the Larboard and
long in waist boat got fast the Larboard boat parted
iron strap the waist boat took one along
side saw in the school a large whale
king struggled could not get fast to him
at 4 PM waist boat cut the whale
in two and hove him in on deck at night
blared him away

8.20 Thursday June the 30
Commences with strong wind commenced
boiling at 1 PM saw whales being rugged did
not lower for them at 2 PM finished boiling
