breezes went on shore for the Doctor he came
on board to see a sick man while a woman
a Plaster he expired with a fever and effected
rest after an illness of 8 days belonged to
Utica at 4 PM went ashore to a small island
and buried him

Commences with all hands Employed
stowing Downe oil

Wednesday Jan 25th
Commences with pleasant weather this day
shipped two men had Rice and Beans
come on board

Thursday Jan 26th
Commences with pleasant weather at daylight
got under way at sunset the Island
of Tangatar bore N.W. Dist 6 leagues
