Long in 41.00 this day was clouded by the mate and had my life threatened latter part equally so ends this day

Friday March 17th

Lat 5.42 S Commences with pleasant weather
Long in 41.00 at 4 PM saw whales the boat
the starboard and starboard boats then the starboard boat parted the boat at sunset took her whale
side so ends this day

Saturday March 18th

Lat 5.38 S Commences with pleasant weather
Long in 41.00 Employed cutting finished at 10 AM saw whales toward the three boats the waist boat parted at 12 AM the Grand L boats whales along side began to cut at 4 PM finished last and love equally began to boil
