Saturday 26 Lat 56-12 S
Long 62-45 W
First of this day strong gale from
S S W. ship heading W S W. under
close reefed main & mizzen
topsails and reefed foresail
middle & latter part the same

Sunday 28th Lat 55-30 S
Long 61-01 W

Tuesday March 1st 1853

First of this day light winds from S W and
rainy weather at 4 wind freshened headed the
topgallant sails & flizill at 5 P M Doubled
the topsails weather very threatening Middle &
Latter part weather changable fog & rain clear
& cloudy gales & moderate weather

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On Board Ship Henry Kneland March 8th

Thursday Feb. This days wind & weather changable
Upon strong gale to whole sale breezes this
24 Hours made 48 Miles western

Friday 4th Lat 55-25 S
Long 62-38 W

First of this day light wind and cloudy weather
At 2 P M. tacked to the South with all sail set
At 4 P M. thick lowering weather head S S W.
Middle & latter part thick light from
N N W. to W. and weather foggy, weather at
at 17 minutes of 12 got an altitude of the sun
and the Lat = Deduced then from 56-10 S
and on at 8-30 minutes of 12 gave the Long
63-12 W

Saturday 5th First of this day light N W wind
and lowering weather all sail out heading
S S W and W S W. Middle part the same
At 6 A M. cleared off and wind changed
to W S W. and blew strong Double reefed
heading S and S by W. at 8 close
reefed the topsails and reefed the main
10 A M. Moderate with clear weather
Lat 56-43 S
Long 63-47 W

Sunday 6th First of this day light wind
and clear weather at 4 P M. wore ship
to the N W. and made sail at 5 P M.
heading N W. by N. weather cloudy & fresh
breeze at 10 P M. tacked to the S W. at wind
N N W. Made all sail heading W S W and S W
Latter part the same Lat 56-37 S Long 65-07
