

Onboard ship Henry Kneeland March 30<sup>th</sup> / 59

Wednesday

This day commences with a strong W.N.W. wind and thick cloudy weather ship Under Double reefed topsails courses jib & spanker at 8 P.M. set the topsails single reefed. This day we are in Lat. 49-30 S. and Long. 80-46 W. We passed Cape St. John the 22<sup>nd</sup> Day of February on the 10<sup>th</sup> Day of March. Passed Cape Horn in sight of it. on the 18<sup>th</sup> arrived to Lat. 57-20 S. Long. 77-47 W. on the 25<sup>th</sup> crossed the Parallel of 55-00 S. Latitude In Long. 79-07 W. on the 25<sup>th</sup> arrived to Lat. 52-15 S. Long. 80-09 W. on the 27<sup>th</sup> to 50-03 S. and 81-17 W. and on the 29<sup>th</sup> to Lat. 48-36 S. and Long. 80-46 W.

On Board Ship Henry Kneeland April 7<sup>th</sup> / 59

Wednesday

First of this day light airs and baffin all sail set steering N.W. the weather cloudy the last two days we have been employed getting up a four & mizen royals and four top gallant studding sail and making a mizen course. the carpenter employed mending the waist Boat that was stove in a gale off Cape Horn. Middle of the latter part of this day fresh N. and N.N.W. wind and thick cloudy weather

On Board Ship Henry Kneeland April 8<sup>th</sup> / 59

Friday

First of this day fresh N and N.N.W. wind and thick rainy weather at 1 P.M. Double reefed the topsails and at 3 close reefed the topsails. Cheafed the courses and changed the jib at 6 P.M. changed the mainsail four and mizen topsails and maintopmast staysail. Blowing a fresh gale from the N. with rain ship heading W. and W.N.W. Middle part wind and weather the same. Latter part wind hauled to the S.W. and cleared off steered N.W. by N. at 6 A.M. made all sail wind strong from S.S.W.

Saturday 9<sup>th</sup>

First of this day strong S.S.W. wind and clear weather steering N.W. by N. studding sails out aloft four main & mizen royals set. at 4 P.M. passing rain squalls changed the mizen royal. Middle part the same latter part weather good and hot as much wind at 6 A.M. set the mizen royal finished the mizen course and bent it. Carpenter making canvas for staysail put out the waist Boat 600

Sunday 10<sup>th</sup>

First of this day fresh S.S.W. wind and good weather all sail set steering N.W. Middle part the same. Latter part wind light from the N.E. steering N.W. Lat 31-42 S Long 87.

Monday 11<sup>th</sup>

First of this day light N.E. wind and good weather steering N.W. with all sail set. Middle and Latter part wind to the north ship by the wind heading W and W.N.W. with all sail set Lat 29 53 Long 88.59 W
