

On Board ship Henry Kneland May 18<sup>th</sup> 1859

Wednesday  
First of this day light NE trade wind and good weather all sail set steering NW by N. at 4 P.M. 95 miles from the Islands of Oike Middle part wind and weather the same at 8 P.M. made the East Point of the Island and steered for Birons Bay. Latter part wind light and showery. Employed getting the anchors off the bow and chains bent and getting out provisions and small stores

Thursday 19<sup>th</sup>  
First of this day light air and showers at 1 P.M. took 6 pilot on board and at 3 P.M. came to anchor in Birons Bay in 5 1/2 fathoms of water with 45 fathoms of chain got up the tables for hoisting. Water bucketed the cask for rafting and scraped the Bends Middle part showery. Latter part one watch on liberty and the other employed getting off water

Friday 20<sup>th</sup>  
First of this day good weather. Watch employed getting off water and stowing it away. Middle part good weather. Latter part the same. The Larboard watch on liberty. Starboard watch getting off wood & water stowing it away &c. Elbridge J. Pateto & James H. Barney war absent when the watch came off.

First of this day fresh trade wind and good weather all sail set steering NW by N. Middle and latter part wind and weather the same steering the same

Thursday June 1<sup>st</sup> 1859

First of this day fresh breeze from NE and good weather all sail out by the wind heading N.N.W. Middle and latter part wind and weather the same

Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup>  
First of this day fresh NE winds and good weather all sail out heading N.N.W. Middle part wind light Latter part calm. Employed setting up the head. Rigin & painting the anchors
