Friday First of this day calm at 5 AM
light airs from the E. N. E. and
breeze all sail set steering N. N. W.

Tuesday First of this day fresh whole
sail breeze from the N. E. and thick
rainy weather all sail set steering
N. W. by N. Middle and latter part
light air and calm employed sailing
out 5 Blackfish that we caught last
Saturday it made 2 1/2 lbs. so End

Wednesday 8th First of this day light airs from
the S. S. E. and cloudy weather at 4 P.M.
Wind freshened set the lower & top mast
studding sails steering N. W. by N. Middle
part the same latter part weather thick and
rainy steering the same

Thursday 9th First of this day strong S. S. W. wind
and thick rainy weather all sail set
steering N. W. by N. at 2 P.M. wind
changed to the West. and cleared up in
studding sails mainmast at 5 top gallant
sails and brace by the wind heading
N. W. by N. Middle part wind and
Weather the same latter wind fresh
and weather Broken steering the
same Lat 45. 53 N

Friday 10th First of this day wind fresh and
variable from S. W. to W. S. W. all sail
set steering N. W. by N. at 5 P.M.
handed the top gallant sails & jib
saw several Birds of the Ducks species
Middle part wind moderate set the
top gallant sails latter part good
Weather and fresh breeze Lat 45. 19 N Long 170. 00 W
