On Board Ship Henry Kneeland July 30
Saturday

This day comes in with fine clear weather
and light North wind steering S.W. with
all sail set saw several muskellonge
Whales some walrus and many Birds
one sail in sight Middle part rain
and fog Latter part thick fog and
Wind N.W. at 8 A.M. hauled the
Light sails and came by the wind
heading N.E. by N. Latitude yesterday
Was 64-39 N. and Long. 174-55 W.

Sunday 31st

This day comes in with strong N.W.
Wind and thick fog ship by the wind under
Whole topsails and jib heading N.E. by N.
At 8 P.M. wind freshened hauled the jib and
Double reefed the topsails at 8 Close reefed
them and fished the courses Middle part
thick fog and rain wind the same as first
part Latter part wind the same and weather
quite clear at intervals at 8 A.M. were to
the S.W. two sail in sight heading
to the S.W.

Monday August 1st 1859

This day comes in with
Cloudy lowering weather and strong North
Wind under close reefed topsails four
top main top & Mizzen staysails
at 2 P.M. turned out a reef out of the
topsails set the four sail jib & spanker
at 7 P.M. were ship to N.E. again
Middle part thick fog and rain Latter part
thick fog wind light and ~~blew~~ in south to East
steering N.W. and south west with all sails
~~set at 8~~ Latter part thick clouds with
no fog



On board ship Henry Kneeland August 2nd 1859
Tuesday

This day comes in with cloudy hazy
Weather all sail set at 8 P.M. wind N.W.
and thick fog at 7 were to the N.E.
Middle part wind and weather the same Latter
part Wind N. weather rainy one sail in sight
Bound Eastward Employed getting out meat
Pickles and small stores

Wednesday 3rd

This day comes in with fresh N. and
N.W. wind and rainy weather heading N.E. and
E.N.E. By the wind with all sail set at 6 P.M.
Soundered gut 24 fathoms water tacked to
the N.W. wind veering to N.N.E. one sail in
sight heading to the S.W. Middle part wind
light weather cloudy but no fog Latter
part weather the same wind N. and N.W.
and very light ship heading W. and
W.N.W. 4 ships in sight Sound west
at 12 Noon Point Hope Bore N. 2 1/2
miles off No whales of any kind
seen this day.

Thursday 4th

This day comes in with light
N. and N.W. wind weather cloudy and
hazy but no fog ship heading W. and
W.N.W. with all sail ~~set~~ one sail in
sight Middle part some light fog and
Wind fresh from N.E. heading N.W. and
N.N.W. Latter part wind the same and
good weather at 8 A.M. tacked to the
E.S.E. at 11 spoke the Bl. Paulina
steer ...
