Tuesday these 24 hours commences with

latter part light winds and variables
off to the west of Comancos
So ends these 24 hours

Wednesday these 24 hours commences with light winds
mar the 31 from the Eastward and very pleasant
1841 with saw a number of ships middle
part light winds and pleasant weather
latter part the same off to the
South of Comancos saw a number
of sail So ends these 24 hours

Thursday these 24 hours commences with
april the 1 light winds from the South and all
1841 round the compass two barks in sight
middle part gentle breeze from the Eastward
latter part strong winds from the
Eastward and pleasant weather off to St
Cibola So ends these 24 hours

Friday these 24 hours commences with strong
april the 2 winds from the Eastward and at 6 PM
1841 came to anchor at St Castalia
middle part fine weather and pleasant
latter part the same
sailing to anchor at St Castalia

Saturday these 24 hours commences with fine
april the 3 winds from the Eastward and pleasant
1841 weather sailing to anchor at St Castalia
middle part gentle breeze from the
Eastward and pleasant weather latter part
the same at 8 AM got underway
at St Castalia So ends these 24 hours

Sunday these 24 hours commences with strong
april the 4 winds from the Eastward and pleasant
1841 irregular in showing anchors and latter
middle part strong winds and pleasant weather
latter part strong winds and squally weather
off to the South of the East land of
Portorico So ends these 24 hours

Monday these 24 hours commences with strong winds
april the 5 from the Eastward and squally at 6 PM
1841 off to the South of the dead chest piece
middle part strong winds from the Eastward
latter part the same off to the South of
Portorico So ends these 24 hours

Tuesday these 24 hours commences with strong
april the 6 winds from the Eastward and some
1841 squally middle part the same off to the
South of the dead chest. raged weather
latter part strong winds and raged
So ends these 24 hours

Wednesday these 24 hours commences with strong
april the 7 winds from the Eastward and raged
1841 weather off to the West of the dead chest
middle part strong winds from the Eastward
and raged weather latter part the
same off to the South of the
dead chest Portorico
So ends these 24 hours
