part fine weather off to the south of Cape
Rosco So ends these 24 hours

Saturday these 24 hours commences with gentle
breezes from the eastward and pleasant
1841 at 6 P.M. off to the south of Lamona
middle part light winds from the eastward
and pleasant weather latter part light winds
from the eastward and pleasant
So ends these 24 hours off to the south of Lamona

Sunday these 24 hours commences with light winds from the
eastward and pleasant weather off to the south of
1841 the job of Lanna middle part fine weather
latter part the same at 11 A.M. saw a
Sperm whale board the boat but did not
get fast going quick So ends these 24 hours

Monday these 24 hours commences with light winds
from the eastward and pleasant weather
1841 middle part light winds from the east
latter part gentle breeze from the
eastward and pleasant weather
off to the south of the Cape of
Demingo So ends these 24 hours

Tuesday these 24 hours commences with light winds from
south and eastward of pleasant weather
1841 middle part gentle breeze from the eastward
and pleasant weather latter part the same off
to the south of the attorney rocks
So ends these 24 hours

Wednesday these 24 hours commences with light winds
from the eastward and pleasant weather middle
1841 part light winds from the eastward latter
part light winds from the eastward and pleasant
weather off to the south of Cape Rosco
So ends these 24 hours

Thursday these 24 hours commences with light
winds from the eastward and pleasant
1841 weather off to the south of Cape Rosco
middle part light winds from the eastward
and pleasant weather latter part the same
at 12 o'clock came to anchor at St. Jago
Cove St. Domingo So ends these 24 hours

Friday these 24 hours commences with gentle breeze
from the south and westward getting off
1841 water middle part light winds from the
south and westward and pleasant weather
latter part the same off lands in sight
in getting off weather and good
So ends these 24 hours

Saturday these 24 hours commences with light winds
from the south and westward and pleasant
1841 weather middle part light winds from the south
latter part the same at 6 A.M. got
under way from St. Jago Cove
St. Domingo So ends these 24 hours
