Monday these 24 hours commences lit winds
april 19 from the South and westward of pleasant
1841 weather off to the South of the white cliffs saw
grampases middle part lit winds from the
South latter part the same at 6 a.m.
saw sperm whales board the boat and
the Harbour boat went along side and mist
So ends these 24 hours

Tuesday these 24 hours commences with strong lit
april 20 winds from the South and pleasant weather
1841 saw grampases middle part strong winds
from the Eastward and rugged latter part
lit winds from the South and pleasant
off to the South of the white cliffs
So ends these 24 hours

Wednesday these 24 hours commences with lit
april 21 winds from the Eastward of pleasant
1841 off to the South of the white cliffs
middle part lit winds from the Eastward
and pleasant weather latter part the same
off to the South of Sackville
So ends these 24 hours

Thursday these 24 hours commences with lit winds
april 22 from the Eastward and pleasant weather
1841 middle part lit winds from the Eastward
latter part the same off to the South
of the Island of Lavath
So ends these 24 hours

Friday these 24 hours commences with lit winds from
april 23 the Eastward saw one sail to the South off to the
1841 South of the Isle of Lavath middle part lit winds
and pleasant weather one sail in the latter part
lit wind off to the South of the Isle of Lavath
So ends these 24 hours

Saturday these 24 hours commences with lit winds from
april 24 the Eastward and pleasant weather off to the
1841 South of the Isle of Lavath middle part lit
winds from the Eastward and pleasant weather
latter part the same off to the South of
Cape Tiborone So ends these 24 hours

Sunday these 24 hours commences with lit winds from
1 25 Eastward and pleasant at 5 p.m. saw a sperm
1841 whale board the boat but did not give fast
middle part fine weather latter part lit winds
and pleasant saw three sails to the South of us
off to the East of the Isle of Navara
So ends these 24 hours

Monday these 24 hours commences with lit winds
april 26 from Eastward and pleasant weather middle
1841 part the same latter part lit winds and
pleasant weather off to the South and westward
of the Isle of Navara no sails in sight
So ends these 24 hours

Tuesday these 24 hours commences with lit winds
april 27 from the Eastward and pleasant weather
1841 middle part fine weather and pleasant weather
latter part the same at 11 a.m.
spoke the brig Victoria bound to
London So ends these 24 hours
