April 29 light winds from the eastward and
1841 pleasant weather middle part light wind

same off to the south of Jamaica

Friday these 24 hours commences with light
April 30 winds from the north and westward
1841 and pleasant weather at 4 m saw three
boats, and found it to be
Ships middle part fine weather
at 10.27 latter part the same nothing in sight
by 19.31 so ends these 24 hours

Saturday these 24 hours commences with light
May 1 winds to eastward and pleasant
1841 weather middle part light winds from the
north and westward and pleasant weather
at 10.22 latter part the same saw one sail
by 11.38 to the north so ends these 24 hours

Sunday these 24 hours commences with light
May 2 winds from the north and westward
1841 one sail in sight to the north of us
middle part light winds from the north
latter part strong winds from the
north and pleasant weather one sail
at 19.22 in sight so ends these 24 hours
by 22.07.30

Monday these 24 hours commences with strong winds
May 3 from the north one sail in sight of us
1841 middle part light winds from the north and
eastward and pleasant weather latter part
at 20.23 the same two sails in sight of us to day
by 23.21 so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday these 24 hours commences with light winds from
May 4 the north and eastward and pleasant weather
1841 middle part light winds from the eastward and
pleasant weather latter part the same two
at 21.07 sails in sight of us to day steering N by
by 24.23 so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday these 24 hours commences with light winds
May 5 from the eastward and pleasant weather
1841 middle part light winds from the south and east
latter part the same at 9 a.m. saw one
antenna bearing by compass with light 5 m
at 22.23 three sails in sight of us to day
by 25.23 so ends these 24 hours

Thursday these 24 hours commences with light winds
May 6 from the south and eastward and pleasant
1841 three sails in sight of us to day middle
part light winds from the south and eastward
at 24.11 and pleasant weather latter part the same one
by 26.11 sail in sight so ends these 24 hours

Friday these 24 hours commences with light winds
May 7 from the eastward one sail in sight of us
1841 middle part light winds from the south and
eastward latter part the same saw two
at 26.23 sails to the eastward on the wind
by 27.14 so ends these 24 hours
