Oct the 1 from the North and squally water
1841 part the same latter part strong winds
from the North laying to anchor at 3 P.M.
So ends the 26 hours

Saturday the 26 hours Commences strong winds
Oct the 2 from the North and squally water
middle part the same latter part
strong winds from the North
at 10 A.M. got under way at 3 P.M.
and went to sea
So ends the 26 hours

Sunday the 26 hours Commences with strong
Oct the 3 winds from the North and squally water
1841 middle part strong winds from the
North and westward and squally water
latter part the same off to the Eastward
of Berasa So ends the 26 hours

Monday the 26 hours Commences with strong
Oct the 4 winds from the North and westward
1841 and squally off to the Eastward of Berasa
middle part strong wind from the
North and westward and thick squally
water latter part the same at 10 A.M.
spoke the ship from a group of
Providence town off to the East
of Berasa So ends the 26 hours
