by 27.10 of Angora So ends the 26 hours

Thursday the 26 hours commences with strong
Oct to 7 winds from the North and westward
1841 and very rough weather middle part like
winds from the North and eastward
and some squally latter part like winds
at 31.45 and pleasant weather off St. Michaels tower
by 25.35 So ends the 26 hours

Friday the 26 hours commences with strong winds
Oct to 8 from the North and eastward and pleasant weather
1841 middle part like winds and pleasant weather
at 31.38 latter part the same off to the South of
by 25.31 St. Michaels So ends the 26 hours

Saturday the 26 hours commences with like winds from
Oct to 9 the eastward and pleasant weather off to
1841 to South of St. Michaels middle part
breeze from the South and
westward and pleasant weather latter part
at 31.11 the same off to the East of St.
by 26.58 Marys So ends the 26 hours

Sunday the 26 hours commences with strong winds
Oct to 10 from the South and westward and a barke
1841 to the wind and middle part strong winds from
South and westward latter part like winds from
at 35.52 South and westward and pleasant weather
26.01 So ends the 26 hours

Monday the 26 hours commences with strong late
Oct to 11 winds from the South and westward middle
1841 part like winds from the South and westward
latter part the same at 4/9 a.m. saw a sperm
at 35.00 also saw the boats but did not get the day
26.00 So ends the 26 hours

Tuesday the 26 hours commences with like winds from the
Oct to 12 North and pleasant weather approaching gale at
1841 4 P.M. got fast to a whale and killed him at
stroke him along side middle part like winds
from the Eastward latter part the winds all
round the compass and some rain employed
at 34.55 cutting in the whale
by 23.01 So ends the 26 hours

Wednesday the 26 hours commences with strong
Oct to 13 winds from all round the compass
1841 employed in cutting in the whale
middle part strong winds from the South
and Eastward latter part the same one
at 34.45 sail in sight employed in cutting
by 23.41 So ends the 26 hours

Thursday the 26 hours commences with strong
Oct to 14 breezes from the South and Eastward
1841 and cloudy weather employed in cutting
middle part the same latter part strong
winds from the Eastward at 8 A.M.
spoke the ship crewed of Norwegians
at 34.00 at 11 a.m. saw a sperm whale and the boat
by 23.30 and the back brace of sail. Galed so
