So ends the 26 hrs

Tuesday the 26 hrs commences with
April 19 strong winds from the Eastward
1842 and pleasant weather at St Thomas
middle part the same
latter part fine weather and
So ends the 26 hrs

Wednesday the 26 hrs commences with
April 20 strong winds from the Eastward
1842 and pleasant weather middle part
light breezes from the Eastward
and pleasant weather latter part
the same So ends the 26 hrs
off to the south of Crab Island

Thursday the 26 hrs commences with gentle
April 21 breezes from the Eastward and pleasant
1842 weather off to the south of Portoreco
middle part strong winds from the Eastward
latter part strong winds from the Eastward
So ends the 26 hrs off to the
south of Portoreco

Friday the 26 hrs commences with strong winds
April 22 from the Eastward and pleasant weather
1842 at 1 P.M. came to anchor at the Dead
Chest middle part gentle breezes from the
Eastward and pleasant weather latter part
the same in play and in fitting rigging
So ends the 26 hrs

Saturday the 26 hrs commences with gentle
April 23 breezes from the Eastward and pleasant
1842 middle part gentle breezes from the
Eastward and pleasant weather at anchor
at the Dead Chest
So ends the 26 hrs

Sunday the 26 hrs commences with gentle
April 24 breezes from the Eastward middle
1842 part strong winds from the Eastward
and pleasant weather latter part the
same at 5 P.M. got under way from
the Dead Chest and stood to the west
at 11 P.M. saw several whals from the
boats and got two of them
So ends the 26 hrs

Monday the 26 hrs commences with gentle breezes
April 25 from the Eastward all kinds in play and
1842 in cutting in whals at 6 P.M. got three
middle part strong winds and raged
latter part the same off to the south of Portoreco
So ends the 26 hrs
