may 11 from the Eastward and pleasant weather
1842 in same bay middle part strong winds
from the Eastward better part strong winds
from the Eastward and raged with so
the 31 June

Thursday the 1 July Commences with strong winds
may 12 from the Eastward and raged with off to the
1842 west of Cape Lopez middle part strong
winds from the Eastward and raged with
better part the same off to the south of the
white Cliffs so ends the 1 July
