leading to the south latter part the
Ht 3.58 same so ends there 24 hours one
by 85.45 sails in site of ship

Monday there 24 hours commences with little
June 6 winds from the eastward one sail in
1842 site leading to the south and pleasant
middle part little winds from the
south and eastward and pleasant
weather latter part the same nothing in
Ht 3.22 site to day leading to the south
by 85.20 so ends there 24 hours

Tuesday there 24 hours commences with little wind
June 7 from the south and pleasant weather
1842 leading to the eastward middle part gentle
breeze from the south and eastward latter part
Ht 2.16 the same one sail in site of ship English
by 84.15 Collins brig so ends there 24 hours

Wednesday there 24 hours commences with little
June 8 winds and variables thunder and rain
1842 in site of us middle part little wind
from the eastward and pleasant weather
latter part the same one brig in site
Ht 24.07 to the windward so ends there 24 hours
by 83.58

Thursday there 24 hours commences with
June 9 little winds from the eastward there
1842 sails in middle part gentle breeze
from the eastward and pleasant weather
latter part the same three sails in
Ht 24.10 site of us to day
by 83.11.00 so ends there 24 hours

Friday there 24 hours commences with gentle breeze
June 10 from the eastward and pleasant weather in site
1842 leading to the middle part Calms tender and
littering latter part little winds from the eastward
Ht 24.00 pleasant weather two sails in site
by 83.45 so ends there 24 hours

Saturday there 24 hours commences with little wind from
June 11 the south and eastward and heavy squalls and
1842 middle part gentle breeze from the south
and pleasant weather latter part the same at 12
O'clock the double head shot they hit him
Ht 23.55 bearing east Dist 10 miles
by 80.50 so ends there 24 hours

Sunday there 24 hours commences with gentle
June 12 breeze from the south and pleasant weather
1842 blowing middle part the same a number
of ships in site of us latter part
Ht 24.15 thick rain weather so battered
by 89.50 so ends there 24 hours

Monday there 24 hours commences with little
June 13 winds from the south and thick
1842 weather a number of sails in site
middle part strong squalls from the south
and eastward and thick weather latter part
Ht 24.50 the same some sails in site of us
by 81.00 so ends there 24 hours

Tuesday there 24 hours commences with strong winds
June 14 from the south and eastward a number of
1842 sails in site middle part strong winds
from the south and eastward same sails in
site latter part the same strong winds from
the eastward and squally weather
Ht 28.29 saw a whales barke
by 79.00 so ends there
