At 35.57 in site of us to day
by 39.12 so ends the 24 hours

Wednesday the 24 hours commences with like winds
July 20 from the westward at 8 P.M. picked up
1842 at 10 P.M. saw a ship with the chain sling
and one alone sheet and his pendant
middle part like winds from the north
and pleasant weather latter part strong
At 36.27 winds from the Eastward and squally
by 37.51 so ends the 24 hours

1842 in site middle part strong winds from

At 35.21 latter part the same one sail in site of us
by 36.47 so ends the 24 hours

Friday the 24 hours commences with strong winds
July 22 from the North and Eastward and aged with
1842 two sails in site of us middle part gentle
breezes from the Eastward and pleasant weather
At 36.50 latter part the same three sails in site of us today
by 37.23 so ends the 24 hours

Saturday the 24 hours commences with like winds
July 23 from the Eastward and pleasant weather two
1842 sails in site of us to day middle part
like winds from the North and Eastward
and pleasant weather latter part the same
At 36.39 two sails in site of us
by 36.24 so ends the 24 hours
