Saturday the 24 hours commences with light
Dec 24 winds from the Eastward and pleasant weather
1842 middle part light winds from the East
and pleasant weather latter part the
light 25.05 same saw two sails to the North
by 60.53 So ends the 24 hours

Sunday the 24 hours commences with light
Dec 25 winds from the Eastward and pleasant
1842 saw a finback middle part light winds
from the South and Eastward latter part
light 26.40 the same one ship in sight to the North
by 62.39 So ends the 24 hours

Monday the 24 hours commences with light

from the North and Westward and
