Dec 31 winds from the south and westward
1843 and squally middle part with strong gale
from the westward and squally weather
latter part strong winds from the
Ht 30.50 south and westward and very squally
by 67.50 with in site So ends these 24 hours

Sunday these 24 hours commences with a strong
Jan 1 gale from the south and westward
1843 very squally and very squally in the
middle part strong winds from the
south and westward and squally weather
latter part the winds from the south
Ht 30.55 and westward saw a vessel steering to
by 68.00 the south So ends these 24 hours

Monday these 24 hours commences with light
Jan 2 from the south and eastward and squally
1843 with squally in the middle part the wind
from all round the compass the latter part
light wind from the westward
Ht 31.30 and pleasant weather with in site
by 68.30 So ends these 24 hours

Tuesday these 24 hours commences with the wind
Jan 3 from the westward and pleasant weather with
1843 light to day middle part gentle breeze from
the westward and pleasant latter part strong
winds from the westward and squally with
Ht 32.02 saw a bird to the south of us
by 69.50 So ends these 24 hours

Wednesday these 24 hours commences with strong
Jan 4 winds from the south and westward and
1843 squally and very squally weather and lightning
middle part a strong gale from the south
and westward latter part strong winds from
Ht 32.30 the south and very squally weather with in site
by 70.41 So ends these 24 hours

Thursday these 24 hours commences with strong
Jan 5 winds from the north and squally
1843 with in site middle part light winds from
the south and eastward and pleasant weather
latter part the same saw a bird to the
Ht 33.02 south bound to the south
by 70.49 So ends these 24 hours

Friday these 24 hours commences with the wind from
Jan 6 the south at 4 P.M. heard a number of
1843 up beneath of hub 56 feet high at least
some plank cut a hole in the bottom
middle part light wind from the south
Ht 33.50 and pleasant weather latter part the same
by 71.13 with in site So ends these 24 hours

Saturday these 24 hours commences with light wind
Jan 7 from the south and cloudy weather with
1843 in the middle part gentle breeze from
the south and pleasant weather latter
Ht 35.58 part the same with in site
by 71.41 So ends these 24 hours
