Thursday

Oct 2 these 24 hours commences with strong winds from the south and thick smoky weather off to the south East of Perceira four sails in situ middle part lite winds from the Eastward and a heavy swell on latter part the same at 8 AM saw a sperm whale passed the boats but did not get fast so ends these 24 hours

Oct 3 these 24 hours commences with lite winds from Eastward and a heavy swell on clearing whole middle part lite winds from the westward and pleasant weather latter part the same at 9 AM saw sperm whale passed the boats and a chest of bay and got nothing so ends these 24 hours
