These 24 hours Commences with light
breezes from the south and westward
one sail in sight middle part
gentle breezes from the south and
westward latter part the same
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 38° 52' long 71° 45' W

Tuesday
July 3
1838

These 24 hours Commences with light
strong breezes from the south west
middle part gentle breezes from
the south west latter part the
same saw a ship to the east
standing to the south
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 38° 26' long 70° 00' W

Wednesday
July 4
1838

These 24 hours Commences with
gentle breezes from the south
and westward at 4 P.M. saw
black and bore the boats but did
not get fast to them
middle part gentle breezes from
the westward latter part light
winds from the eastward
one ship in sight to the
eastward of us
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 36° 56' long 69° 00' W
