Friday  
July 6  
1838

These 24 hours commences with  
strong breezes from the westward  
and squally with setting in the  
middle part strong winds from  
the N. S. W. and raged with  
latter part the same saw a  
Ship to the south bound to the  
Eastward So ends these 24 hours  
Lat obs 34.26 Long 69.00 or 6.

Saturday  
July 7  
1838

These 24 hours commences with  
strong breezes from the N. S. W.  
and raged with setting in the  
middle part strong winds  
latter part the same saw  
one brig to the south of us  
bearing to the south and  
one schooner the same  
So ends these 24 hours  
Lat obs 32.22 Long 69.05 or
