July the 15
1838

these 24 hours Commences with Lite
winds from the south all hands in by
in clearing up decks and popping out the
whale middle part Lite wind and
Cloudy latter part the same saw many
So Ends these 24 hours

Lat obs 32.24 Long 74.00 N

Monday
July the 16
1838

these 24 hours Commences with Lite
winds from the North and Eastward
middle part Lite winds from the
North latter part the same saw
two sails in site of us
So Ends these 24 hours

Lat obs 32.05 Long 75.00 N
