Saw
whales
and got
one
18

Here 24 hours Commences with
gentle breezes from the westward
at 2 p.m. saw breacher to the windward
looked the boats but did not see what
they name at 6 p.m. saw sperm
whales board the boat got fast and
got one at 10 p.m. took him along
side middle part like wind latter
part strong wind, shook a piece all
in logade in cutting is the whale at 12
o'clock got there 10 miles then 24
lat abs 31.35 S long 14.30 W

Saturday
July the 21
1888

Here 24 hours Commences with gentle
breezes from the westward in logade
in boiling the whale middle part
strong winds off land in logade
latter part the same saw one
sail to the south of us
19 miles then 24 hours
lat abs 32.14 S long 14.56 W

Sunday
July the 22
1888

Here 24 hours Commences with
strong winds from the westward
all land in logade in boiling the
whale at 6 p.m. got there saw a
ship to the south bound to get
middle part strong wind latter
part the same all being in log
strong down to sail 10 miles
lat abs 31.39 S long 14.50 W
