breezes from the N.W. the whales
went off to the westward very fast
Saw one sail to the South of us
middle part strong winds from the
South west and aged weather latter
part the same saw one sail to
the South So Ends these 24 hours
Lat abt 32.55 S Long 73. 31 or 0

Thursday
August 2nd
1838

These 24 hours Commences with strong
breezes from the South west and aged
middle part strong winds from
the South west latter part the
same aged saw a beach
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat abt 33.59 S Long 73. 07 or 0

Friday
August 3rd
1838

These 24 hours Commences with
strong winds from the South west
middle part strong wind and
squadly thunder and lightning
and rain latter part the
same nothing in sight of us.
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat 34. 08. Long 72. 21. 30 or 0
