 Schooner to the North of us
 middle part Strong winds from the
 S & E latter part the same saw
 a Barque to the South of her
 both steaming East
 So Ends these 24 hours
 Lat obs 36.41 long by Chron 57.01

Friday
 August
 the 17
 1838
 These 24 hours Commences with Strong
 winds from the S & E one sail in sight
 middle part of light winds from the
 Eastward latter part Strong winds
 from the South and East three sails
 in sight all bound to the Eastward
 So Ends these 24 hours
 Lat obs 36.14 S long by Chron 55.21

Saturday
 August
 the 18
 1838
 These 24 hours Commences with Strong
 winds from the S & E three sails
 in sight of us middle part Strong
 winds from the South latter part
 the same nothing in sight of us
 So Ends these 24 hours
 Lat obs 36.59 S long by Chron 51.50.30
