these 24 hours Commences with strong  
winds from the N.W. and some  
squally middle part some squalls  
of rain later fine weather saw  
a Schooner to the North bound to  
the Eastward so ends these 24 hours  
Lat obs 36° 32' S Long 38° 30' W

Sunday  
August  
the 26  
1838

these 24 hours Commences with rather  
fresh from the S.W. at 2 pm  
saw whale load the boats and got one  
at 6 pm took line along side  
middle part strong fresh from the  
N.W. of latter part the same and  
ruled all hands employed in cutting  
in the whale so ends these 24 hours  
Lat obs 36° 20' S Long 38° 00' W

Monday  
August  
the 27  
1838

these 24 hours Commences with  
strong winds from the N.W. &  
all hands employed in cutting in  
middle part like winds and a  
heavy swell over latter part  
like winds and pleasant weather  
lands employed in boiling  
so ends these 24 hours  
Lat obs 36° 30' S Long 38° 05' W
