1838

There 24 hours Commences with light
winds from the South and Eastward
at 2 Pm saw sperm whales and
two boats and got one of them -
middle part fine weather latter
part the same all hands
employed in cutting in the whale
at 12 o'clock got threw cutting
So Ends there 24 hours -
Lat 36° 32' Long 38° 26' W

Friday
September
the 7
1838

There 24 hours Commences with
gentle breeze from the Southwest
one Gale in site in forenoon
boiling middle part strong
wind from the Southwest
latter part the same all
hands employed in boiling
So Ends there 24 hours -
Lat 36° 26' Long 38° 42' W

Saturday
September
the 8
1838

There 24 hours Commences with strong
breeze from the Southwest one sail
in site middle part rainy some
thunder and lightning at 6 Pm
got threw boiling and went to
stowing down latter part all hands
employed in stowing down two sails
in site So Ends there 24 hours
Lat 36° 08' Long 38° 23' W
