these 24 hours Commences with strong
winds from the south and rugged weather
middle part Strong winds from
the N. E. and squally raining latter
part the same saw nothing but
small fish so ends the 24 hours
Lat obs 36. 15 Long 37. 32

Thursday
September
the 13

these 24 hours Commence with strong
breezes from the N. E. and rugged
at 4 p.m. saw a large brack to the wind
middle part Strong winds from the
south and Eastward at 12 minute
the winds came to the south latter
part pleasant but a heavy swell
so ends the 24 hours
Lat obs 37. 00 Long 37. 11

Friday
Sept the 14
1838

these 24 hours Commences with
light winds from the south and
pleasant weather middle part
calms some cloudy latter gentle
breezes from the north at 6 a.m.
saw black fish heard the boats and
got fast to one and drew the iron
winds came to the south
so ends the 24 hours
Lat obs 37. 20 Long 38. 02
