these 24 hours Commenced with light
winds from the Southward & steamed
to angra Terana western Islands -
at 6 P.M. came on board steamed off
South good weather middle part fine
weather latter part the same saw
a finback So Ends these 24 hours
Lat also 38° 26' Long 26° 52'

Sunday
October
the 7
1838

these 24 hours Commenced with light winds
from the South and pleasant weather
middle part fine weather off to the
South of Terana latter part fine
weather Steaming down to the Eastward
at 12 o'clock saw St. Michaels bearing
by Compass E S E Dist 40 miles
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat 38° 52' Long 26° 30'

Monday
October
the 8
1838

these 24 hours Commenced with light
winds from the South and pleasant weather
at 5 P.M. saw some birds of prey but
could not tell what these were
middle part strong wind from the
E S E latter part the same
at 8 A.M. saw a ship to the windward of
us at 10 A.M. part & steamed to the
Leeward bound to the South
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat also 38° 10' Long 26° 06'
