1838

these 24 hours Commences with strong
breezes from the E & E by E all to
the N of St Michaels middle part
Strong winds from the same later
part Strong winds at 8 am saw
a portugee brig beating up along
the island at 12 we were abreast of
the city of Yelgoroda St Michaels
So ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 37.44 Long is 25.45

Friday
October
the 10
1838

these 24 hours Commences with
light breezes from the E & E saw a
Ship running down the strait
middle part Strong winds from the
Eastward later part the same
at 8 am saw a schooner bound to
the south at 12 O'clock we were a
breast of St Marys town
So ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 36.45 Long is 25.38

Saturday
October
the 11
1838

these 24 hours Commences with strong
winds from the Eastward and squally weather
middle part Strong winds from the
Eastward later part the same saw
two sails to the south bound to the
south west rapid weather
So ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 35.27 Long 23.24
