Strong winds from the S.E. and
raged weather latter part the same
Strong winds and thick weather
So Ends the 24 hours

Friday
October
the 19
1838

the 24 hours Commences with strong
winds from the North and Eastward and
thick ragged weather settling in at
middle part Strong winds and squally
at 8 a.m. spoke the brig Orin of
rochester and saw the brig Solon of
rochester bound to Cay-6 de winds -
So Ends the 24 hours
Lat ab 21. 36 S Long 18. 30

Saturday
October
the 20
1838

the 24 hours Commences with strong
winds from the S.E. and ragged
and squally weather some raining
middle part Strong winds from the
S.E. and a heavy swell on latter
part the same at 10 a.m. saw a
sloop standing to the South ad west
So Ends the 24 hours
Lat ab 21. 21. Long 18. 45
