the 26
1838

these 24 hours commences with light winds
from the S E and varying weather
middle part light winds from the South
and thick weather latter part light winds
from the South and Eastward and pleasant
So ends these 24 hours
Set at 16. 55 S by 21. 20 or

Saturday
October
the 27
1838

these 24 hours commences with light winds from
the South and Eastward middle part light winds
from the S E latter part the same at
6 a.m. saw the Isle of St. Lawrence by
Compass N. by West 90
Set at 16. 45 S by 22. 00 or
