winds from the E & S E and pleasant weather
at 4 p.m. went over shore to palmaria to sea
the Counsel middle part strong winds taking
part the same So Ends this 24 hours

Friday
November
the 2
1838

There 24 hours Commences with Strong winds
from the E & S E middle part the same
latter part strong winds at 1 a.m. got
under way at maraca bay for the south
point to get wood at 11 a.m. came ten
miles Ends this 24 hours

Saturday
November
the 3
1838

There 24 hours Commences with strong
winds from the E & S E at 5 p.m. got up
wood on board got up anchor and went to sea
middle part strong winds from the E & S E
latter part the same at 12 O'clock saw
the island of Jago and St Jago

So Ends this 24 hours
Lat obs 13° 24' Long 4° 40' 10"

Sunday
November
the 4
1838

There 24 hours Commences with strong breezes
from the E & S E in between Jago and St Jago.
middle part winds variables latter part
strong breezes and pleasant weather nothing in sight
So Ends this 24 hours
Lat obs 13° 13' Long 2° 50' 27"

Monday
November
the 5
1838

There 24 hours Commences with gentle breezes from
the E & S E middle part gentle breezes from the
E & S E latter part fine weather at 11 a.m.
saw a finch (sp?) the boats but Coats.
not get part to him
So Ends this 24 hours

Lat obs 11° 29' Long 4° 40' 22" 50"
