Lat abt 46. 46. Long by Chronometer 22. 03. 00

Thursday
November
the 8
1838

these 26 hours Commences with Lte winds
from the Eastward falling in afternoon
middle part gentle rain from the South
East latter part some heavy squalls
of wind and rain some thunder
so Com. these 26 hours
Lat abt 22. 08. 00

Friday
November
the 9
1838

these 24 hours Commences with Lte
winds at 3 p.m. saw a heavy squall
from the S & E at 4 p.m. saw a
sail to the S & E after middle part Lte
winds and pleasant latter part Calms
Lat abt 7. 12. Long by Chronometer 22. 45. 00

Saturday
November
the 10
1838

these 24 hours Commences with Lte winds
from the S & E and this sail in sight after
middle part Lte winds from the S & E
and pleasant latter part Lte winds from
the South saw three ships bound to the
Westward so Com. these 26 hours
Lat abt 5. 55. Long 22. 45. 00

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
