December from the E. S. E. and squally weather nothing
the 2 side middle part strong winds from the
1898 Eastward and some lashing squalls latter
the same a breeze in side at 10 am saw
whales feeding the but did not get past this day
so ends Lat obs 16.55 S long 36.29 W

Monday these 24 hours commences with strong winds
December from the Eastward whales in side boat all
the 8 at 2 pm got fast and got one at 4 pm
1898 took him along side and went to cutting
middle part strong winds had some squalls
rain latter part strong winds all night in
in cutting in at 11 am broke the brig and
minerals of balliver East side
Lat obs 17.10 S long 36.45 W

Tuesday these 24 hours commences with strong winds from
December North and Eastward all lands in side in
the 4 cutting in the whale middle part strong
1898 winds latter part the same all lands in side
in cutting in the whale ganks so ends
Lat obs 17.26 S long 37.00 W

Wednesday these 24 hours commences with strong winds
December from Eastward in side in boiling spoke
the 5 the brig below at 10 am middle part
1898 good weather in side in boiling latter
part the same saw 2 brig to the
South so ends the 24 hours
Lat obs 18.11 S long in 36.50 W
