 middle part strong winds at 10 p.m. fresh from
 the land at 6 a.m. got it again latter part
 aged imployade in boiling and taking
 the land So Ends these 24 hours
 Lat obs 17° 15' S long in 37° 22' 30" W

Wednesday
 December
 the 12
 1838
 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds
 and aged weather in boiling and taking
 in the middle part strong winds from
 Eastward latter part the same weather
 in the imployade in boiling
 So Ends these 24 hours
 Lat obs 16° 58' S long in 37° 39" W

Thursday
 December
 the 13
 1838
 these 24 hours Commences with strong winds
 and aged weather imployade in boiling
 middle part gentle Breezes from the S.W.
 latter part the same at 6 a.m. got them
 boiling and went to Stowing down the air
 So Ends these 24 hours
 Lat obs 17° 02' S long 37° 20" W

Friday
 December
 the 14
 1838
 these 24 hours Commences with strong wind
 from the S.W. imployade in Stowing down
 at 6 p.m. spoke the big labarrows of vegetables
 middle part light winds and pleasant weather
 latter part the same imployade in Stowing
 down the sails in the air
 So Ends these 24 hours
 Lat obs 18° 06' S long 36° 45' W

Saturday
 December
 the 15
 1838
 these 24 hours Commences with light wind from
 the S.W. middle part strong winds from the
 Eastward latter part variable winds and squalls
 of rain at 12 o'clock spoke the Cora
 Lopez of Puerto Rico
 Lat obs 18° 06' S long 36° 51' W
