winds from the N.E. these sails in sight
middle part strong winds and squally
latter part the same two sails in sight
So ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 17. 42 Long in 87. 21

Monday
December
the 17
1838
Here 24 hours Commences with strong
winds and squally at 4 p.m. spoke the
brig Sarah of Rochester middle part
strong winds and squally latter part the
same two sails in sight of us
So ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 18. 09 S Long in 87. 15. 30

Tuesday
December
the 18
1838
Here 24 hours Commences with strong winds
from the N.E. and some squalls hanging
round us middle part strong winds and
squally weather latter part the same saw
two sails so ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 17. 55 S Long in 87. 08

Wednesday
December
the 19
1838
Here 24 hours Commences with strong
winds from the south and eastward and squally
middle part strong winds from the E.S.E.
latter part the same the brig Cowley in
sight so ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 17. 30 S Long in 87. 22

Thursday
December
the 20
1838
Here 24 hours Commences with strong
winds from the E.S.E. and squally weather
middle part strong winds and rough
latter part the same nothing in
sight of us so ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 16. 53 S Long in 86. 53
