these 24 hours commences with gentle breezes
from the south and eastward two sails in site
middle part light winds from the south and east
latter part the same one sail in site as
So ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 18° 47' S Long 36° 08' W

Monday
January
the 7
1839

these 24 hours commences with light winds from
the south and eastward and pleasant weather
one sail in site middle part strong winds
from the N & E and some squalls of rain
latter part strong winds and rough two sails
in site So ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 18° 17' S Long 36° 53' W

Tuesday
January
the 8
1839

these 24 hours commences with strong winds
from the N & E two sails in site as
middle part strong winds from the south
and eastward latter part the same
one sail in site as to day
So ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 18° 05' S Long 36° 46' W
