East and good weather latter part the
same one barque in sight of us
So Ends these 24 hours

Wednesday
January
the 30
1839

these 24 hours commences with light winds from
the North and Eastward two sails in sight of us
middle part light winds from the North and
pleasant weather latter part the same three
sails in sight So Ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 18° 20' S Long in 36° 27' W

Thursday
January
the 31
1839

these 24 hours commences with light winds
from the North and Eastward and some heavy
ing squalls middle part light winds from the
North and Eastward and pleasant latter part
the same So Ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 17° 15' S Long in 36° 55' W

Friday
February
the 1
1839

these 24 hours commences with light winds
from the North and Eastward and pleasant weather
middle part light winds from the North and East
latter the same one sail in sight of us
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 16° 41' S Long in 37° 13' W

Saturday
February
the 2
1839

these 24 hours commences with light winds
from the North and Eastward one sail
in sight of us middle part gentle breezes from
North and Eastward latter part the same
saw one sail past to the Westward
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 15° 41' S Long in 37° 09' W

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
