middle part Lite winds from the North and East
Latter part the same nothing in site of us
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 13. 36 S Long by Chron 37. 26 m

Wednesday
February
the 6
1839

these 24 hours Commences with lite winds from
the North and Eastward nothing in site of us
middle part Lite winds from the Eastward
Latter part the same at 7 a m saw the
Land the East of Boats saw one brig
So Ends these 24 hours
Lat obs 12. 49 S Long is by Chron 37. 48 m

Thursday
February
the 7
1839

these 24 hours Commences with Lite winds
from the Eastward a number of Catamarans
in site one brig one large boat & others
middle part Lite winds from the North East
Latter part the same at 8 a m saw a
Sperm whale heard the boat at 12 o'clock
got fast and killed him So Ends these
24 hours
Lat obs 13. 02 Long is by Chron 37. 30 m
